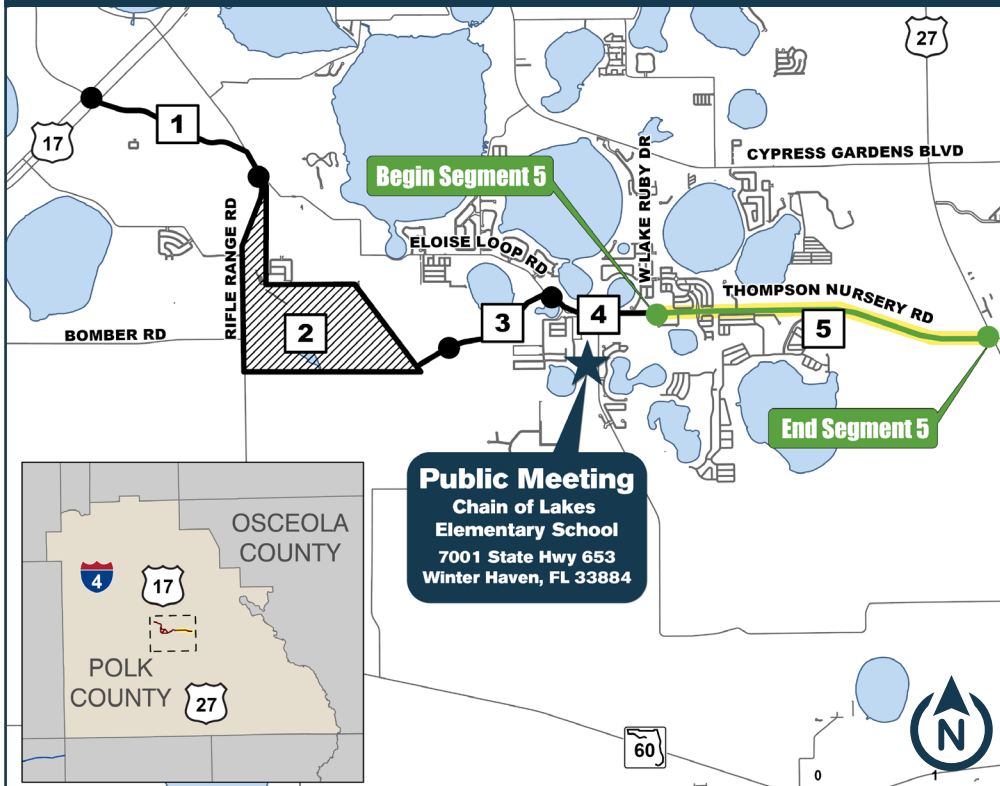

PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING

Polk County invites you to attend and participate in a **Public Information Meeting** for the Thompson Nursery Road Extension project from West Lake Ruby Drive to U.S. 27, scheduled for **Thursday, June 13, 2024** at the **Chain of Lakes Elementary School, 7001 State Highway 653, Winter Haven, FL 33884**. The in-person public meeting (open house format) will be held from 5:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Meeting notices are being sent to all property owners, residents, and businesses located within the project area and to other public officials, regulatory agencies, organizations, and individuals interested in the project.

The County is conducting a Project Development & Environment (PD&E) Study to evaluate widening Thompson Nursery Road from West Lake Ruby Drive to U.S. 27. This will be Segment 5 of the planned 4-lane Thompson Nursery Road extension from U.S. 17 to U.S. 27 (see map below). This project will provide additional roadway network connectivity, increase capacity, improve operational efficiency, enhance safety, and accommodate pedestrian and bicycle activity. These improvements will accommodate the continuous growth in population and employment in the area.
