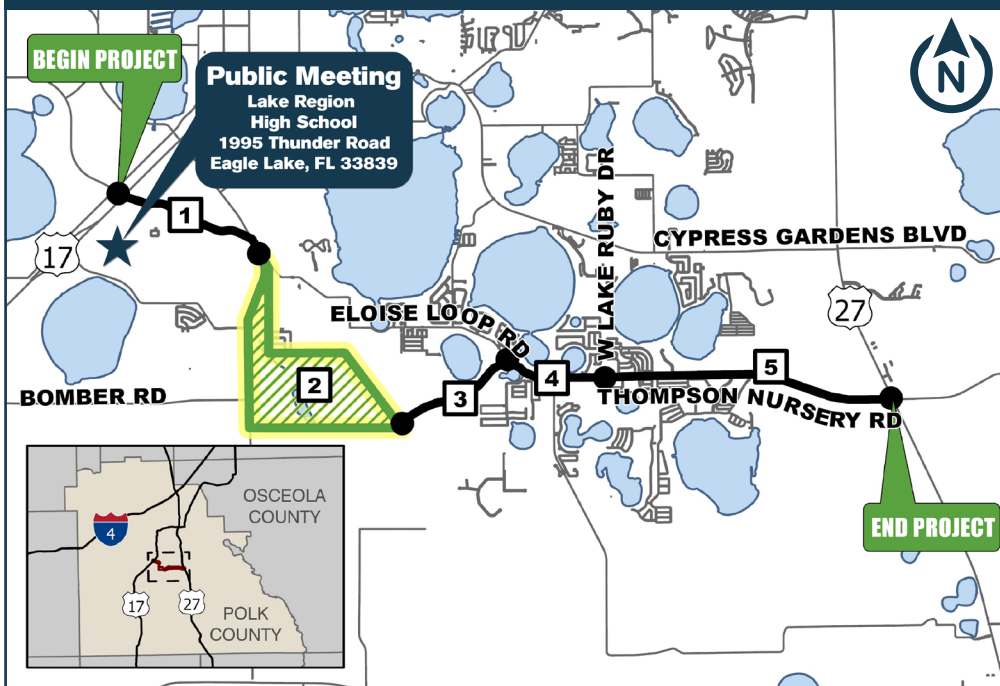
PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING

Polk County invites your participation and feedback at a **Public Information Meeting** for the planned "Segment 2" extension of Thompson Nursery Road (County Road 540A) from Rifle Range Road to east of CSX Railroad. The meeting is being hosted by the Roads & Drainage Division on **Thursday evening, November 14, 2024, from 5:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.** at the **Lake Region High School Cafeteria, 1995 Thunder Road in Eagle Lake.**

The Segment 2 extension is needed to address increasing traffic demands from areawide population and employment growth. A corridor study evaluated differing alignments as part of a multi-phase project extending from U.S. 17 at State Road 540 in Eagle Lake to U.S. 27 in Lake Wales (**see map below**).

To finish the study, Polk County is seeking public input on alignment options being presented. Related exhibits include "Segment 1" graphics showing the connection to U.S. 17. Attendees can view displays and ask questions of County staff and consulting engineers. Feedback is encouraged and comment forms will be provided. After public input and approval by the Board of County Commissioners is received, a recommended option will proceed to final design and construction.
